What is a Residential Home for the Aged?

A Residential Home for the Aged, is a non-medical long term care facility for adults 55 years old and older who can no longer live on their own at home, due to they need round the clock supervision and assistance with their daily living activities such as bathing, eating, grooming, medication reminders, etc.). In addition to assistance with daily living activities, RHA's provide lodging and meal services..

When Should a RHA Be Considered?

A RHA facility should be considered when one can no longer live independently, but do not require the services from a medical long term care facility such as an assisted living or nursing home.

What is the Ambiance and Atmosphere of a RHA?

RHA's offer a smaller, more home-like family setting atmosphere. They offer food services and assistance with daily living activities, but do not typically have a medical professional on-site. RHA's are typically located in traditional homes and neighborhoods and provide care for fewer patients than assisted living communities.

What is the Cost of a RHA?

Living in a RHA is often half the cost of nursing home care, and in some states, it is even more affordable than assisted living care. However, cost can vary depending on the geographical location of the residential home, as well as, the types of services needed. In home care can cost anywhere from \$1,500 a month to \$4,500 each month; and dementia care can cost even more. Cost can also vary depending on room privacy. According to Genworth.com, a RHA facility typically runs \$2,200 a month for a shared bedroom and \$3,400 a month for a private bedroom. Most RHA's have private rooms available for their residents, as well, as shared rooms. RHA's are normally private pay facilities and do not accept Medicaid or Medicare.

Services Offered in RHA's

RHA's offer supervised care, meals, activities and health management. A RHA is a better fit for someone who needs more individual, home-setting care.

Here are some of the basic services offered in RHA's:

- · Comfortable private, or semi-private, rooms
- · 3 daily, home cooked meals
- · Housekeeping and laundry service
- Medication assistance
- · Social programs and activities
